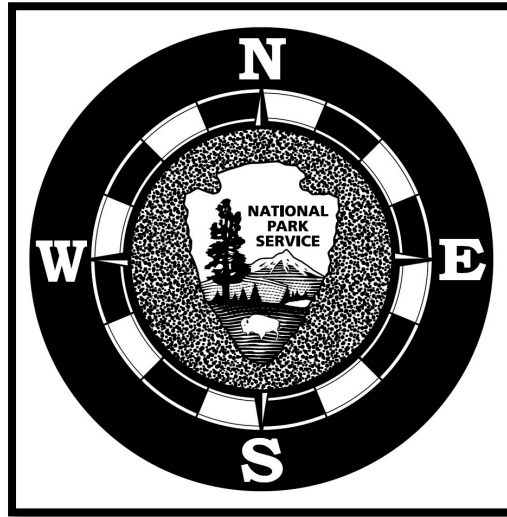


San Francisco Maritime National Historic Park Compass Rose

San Francisco Maritime National Historical Park is home to over 100 historically significant vessels and a world-class collection of Pacific maritime artifacts and documents. Over 350,000 visitors enjoy a number of the park's ships and exhibits at Hyde Street Pier annually.

Good visitor orientation often begins with just being sure that the visitor can get their bearings. This project will produce a heavy steel compass rose that will be installed in a very high traffic area of the Park where it will be inset into the deck of the Hyde Street Pier. The 32 inch disc will indicate the four prime points of the compass all set around the Park Service logo.

The Fund for People in Parks will provide a grant to the **San Francisco Maritime Park Association** for design, manufacture and installation of the compass rose.
